- 2 letters of recommendation (enclosed in a sealed envelope); German applicants: please enclose 1 letter of recommendation
- Certified copy of each obtained university degree, e.g. Bachelor of Science, Master of Science
Statement about degree(s) you plan to complete before entering Bonn or Cologne University
- Certified academic transcript(s)
- Toefl certificate, minimum 79 points internet based or equivalent (German applicants need a short certification about english proficiency issued by one of their professors)
